AHEPA Empire State District 6 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YEAR 2025



The *AHEPA Scholarship Perpetual Fund, Inc.* has scholarship programs, which were established to promote, encourage, induce and advance education currently. The scholarship foundation will accept applications from **graduating high school seniors, College/University students, and high school seniors vocational training.**

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant is a member of a Sons of Pericles chapter in District Six and is in good standing prior to the application deadline date of May 1, 2025;

OR

The applicant is the **son or daughter** of a chapter member of AHEPA in District Six in good standing for 2024 and 2025;

OR

The applicant is the **son or daughter** of a deceased chapter member of AHEPA in District Six who was in good standing at least two years prior to the date of his death;

AND

The applicant **MUST ATTEND** full time (minimum 12 college credits), at an accredited college or university during the current calendar year of the application or attend an accredited vocational school. The applicant must not have been a previous college/university recipient of this Scholarship Program.

AHEPA HS Scholarship and Saint Basil Academy Scholarship

- You must be a **high school senior**
- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit Scholastic Aptitude Test (administered by the College Entrance Examination Board or American College Test/American College Training Program), if available or taken
- Submit high school transcripts or comparable grades

AHEPA College/University Scholarship

- You must be a **full-time student (Freshman-Senior)**
- Minimum 12 semester hours at an accredited college or university
- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit your college transcripts

AHEPA HS Senior Vocational Training

- You must be a **high school senior**
- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit high school transcripts or comparable grades
- Please indicate vocational institution you will attend

FILING

Please **use the enclosed application**. If additional applications forms are needed, please feel free to make copies.

The applicant is responsible for the submission of all documents and completion of all sections of this application and sending the complete application package by **E-MAIL NO LATER THAN MAY 1, 2025 to ahepascholarshiped6@gmail.com**. All information received will be kept confidential. No items will be returned. Indicate by check mark the scholarships for which you are applying.

TRANSCRIPTS

High school seniors must submit the most recent official complete high school transcript **AND SAT or ACT scores (if available or taken)**. **All transcripts must be official and submitted as part of the complete application**. Applicants should provide the name of the college, university or vocational school to which they have been accepted or planning to attend.

College students must submit their transcripts from an accredited college or university. Transcripts must be official and **submitted as part of the complete application**.

ESSAY QUESTION (250-500 words typed, double spaced)
